## Transdisciplinarity is the way to change course

"Humanity is on a collision course with nature," Aurelio Peccei diagnosed in 1981, based on a decade of The Club of Rome's research; and issued the call to action:

"It is absolutely necessary to find a way to change course."

There is a natural way to achieve that, I'll propose in this dialog's introduction; what we now uphold and rely on as "science" needs to become transdisciplinary—capable of integrating insights across disciplines and traditions; and providing trustworthy information about all themes.

To streamline this so timely unfolding, we created a complete prototype of the transdiscipline called knowledge federation. In this second dialog, we'll apply this prototype to pivotal themes including ethics, politics, happiness, creativity, religion, edcation, science, design, art and journalism; and see the way we conventionally comprehend them changed, and their handling reversed.
